

THE FGASA TRAILS GUIDE MENTOR PROCESS



You must be a **Professional Trails Guide*** with at least 3 years workplace experience

You need to be nominated (in writing to FGASA Management) by at least 3 current mentors

The potential new mentor must provide FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee with a comprehensive CV

Attend an interview with the FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee

FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee must agree that the individual is suitable to be a mentor before he/she can be appointed

The potential new mentor must attend a training session

Must support FGASA and believe in what the Association is striving towards

Becoming a Trails Guide Mentor follows the process of being appointed to the position.

It is not guaranteed that you will automatically qualify to become a mentor.
