

THE FGASA ADVANCED RIFLE HANDLING (ARH) CERTIFICATE



The FGASA ARH is a requirement for the Trails Guide Qualification

You need to have an Apprentice Field Guide (NQF2), Field Guide (NQF4) or Professional Field Guide qualification

You need to have been declared competent against the relevant PFTC firearms proficiency unit standards (compulsory)

117705 - Demonstrate knowledge of the Firearms Control Act 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000)

119651 – Handle and Use a Manually operated Rifle

123519 – Handle and Use a Manually operated Rifle for Business Purposes

You may now be practically assessed by a FGASA ARH assessor

The ARH is valid for 3 years, after which you will need to contact a FGASA assessor and redo the practical component

FGASA does not issue a stand-alone ARH certificate

The ARH goes hand-in-hand with a full Trails Guide qualification. If your ARH expires, your trails guide expires

If you work in other African countries and are not required to carry a rifle for trail guiding purposes, you will be awarded the VPDA Certificate (which does not expire).
