

THE FGASA REGIONAL BIRDING (NQF4) CERTIFICATE



You need to have an Apprentice Field Guide (NQF2), Field Guide (NQF4) or Professional Field Guide qualification

Obtain the FGASA Birding Workbook and "Beat about the Bush Birds" (T Carnaby), from the FGASA office

You will need to book for the Birding Slide and Sound assessment (75% pass mark per each slide and sound)

One biome of your choice +
the Core species list

You may now book your birding practical assessment directly with a FGASA assessor (your workbook must be handed in to the assessor)

You need only be practically assessed once on your guiding skills for birding
Each biome has a separate slide and sound assessment

When declared competent in all the above, you will have obtained your Regional Birding (NQF4) qualification

If you complete all 9 biomes (Slide and Sound) you will obtain the National Birding certificate

The cost of the slide and sound assessment is the same as an exam fee.
