You need to register and pay the required fees

Ensure that you receive the required Learning Materials. These include the Culture Guide (NQF4) Learner Manual, Workbook #1, Workbook #2.

Complete the Culture Guide (NQF4) workbooks to prepare for the theory exam. **Compulsory.**

Register online for the Culture Guide (NQF4) theory examination as well as to pay the **exam fee**

You need to be **declared competent** (pass) the FGASA Culture Guide (NQF4) theory examination (75%).

You may now book your practical assessment (directly with a FGASA assessor).

You need to submit your **completed** FGASA Culture Guide (NQF4) **Workbooks (theory and practical)** to your assessor for assessment.

You need to be **declared competent** (pass) for the FGASA Culture Guide (NQF4) **practical assessment.**

The assessment is region specific. You will not obtain a full province.

You will be awarded the **FGASA Culture Guide (NQF4) qualification (CATHSSETA NQF4 Certificate).**



You will need to submit all required further documentation to the FGASA offices for correct registration of your new qualification with CATHSSETA.

A valid first aid certificate is a requirement for all FGASA qualifications

You need to be registered with the National Department of Tourism in order to guide legally.

You need:

- Your FGASA certificate
- Your CATHSSETA certificate
- A certified copy of your first aid
- A certified copy of your ID
