

THE FGASA ARH ASSESSOR PROCESS



You will need to already have all the FGASA Assessor requirements

Be qualified as a FGASA Professional Field Guide (Theory, Practical and Birding) with a minimum of 1 year guiding experience as a Professional Field Guide

Be qualified as a FGASA Professional Trails Guide

Complete the ARH Assessor Application form

**As per FGASA assessor and mentor policy, it is not guaranteed that you will automatically be permitted to assess ARH*

You need to obtain the Range Officer Course Certificate (US123516)

You need to complete the FGASA ARH Assessor Workbook

You need to attend the ARH Assessor workshop

You need to be assessed (and found competent) shooting the ARH Protocols [V2019] – (practical) by an SKS (DG) Assessor

You need to undergo the mentored Assessors Assessment

All ARH Assessors need to shoot their ARH renewal (every 3 years) with an SKS (DG) Assessor

A logged peer-review shoot needs to be completed once every 3 years
