

THE FGASA ASSESSOR PROCESS



You need to be older than 24 years of age

Be qualified with a minimum of FGASA Professional Field Guide (Theory, Practical and Birding) with a minimum of 1 year guiding experience as a Professional Field Guide

If you wish to assess a specialist qualification, you need to be qualified in the relevant specialist qualification or SKS qualification

Complete the Assessor Application form and submit (including your CV) to FGASA

For all new applications at least 5 years full time guiding experience is required

You need to write the FGASA Assessor Theory examination

You need to undergo the Assessor assessment

You need to attend the assessor workshops

You need to have attained the relevant Assessors qualification from the ETDP SETA

You need to have Tracker 1

You may be required to attend an interview

You need to be currently registered as a guide with NDT

You need a valid first aid certificate

All new assessors may only assess NQF2 until such time as the assessor is experienced enough in assessing to assess different qualifications

Becoming a FGASA assessor follows the process of being appointed to the position.

It is not guaranteed that you will automatically qualify to become an assessor.
