## FGASA BIRD GUIDE QUALIFICATIONS PROCESS



- 1. You need to have a Nature Site Guide NQF2, or NQF4 or FGASA Professional Field Guide qualification. And be an up-to-date member of FGASA.
- 2. You need to purchase the FGASA Birding Workbook and "Beat about the Bush Birds" from the FGASA office.
- 3. You will need to book for the Birding Slide and Sound assessment (75% pass mark for slide and 75% pass mark for sound)

## The Assessment will include:

One biome of your choice + the Core species list

The comprehensive list of the biomes and core bird list can be found under the Qualifications Page on the FGASA Website.

**4.** You need to **complete the FGASA Birding Workbook.** This is **compulsory.** 

**5.** You may now **book your birding practical assessment** directly with **a FGASA assessor.** 

You need only be practically **assessed once** on your guiding skills **for birding.** 

Each biome has a separate slide and sound assessment.

6. When declared competent in all the above, you will have obtained your Regional Birding (NQF4) qualification.

## **ADDITIONIAL INFORMATION**

The FGASA Bird Guide Qualification may be used as an Elective Subject for either the Nature Site Guide NQF4 or Professional Field Guide Qualifications.

If you **complete all 9 biomes (Slide and Sound)** you will obtain the **National Birding certificate.**
