- 1. You need to have the FGASA Professional Field Guide qualification. You need to be an up-to-date member of FGASA.
- 2. You need to have completed and passed the Birding Core Slide and Sound as well as at least one (or more) biome assessments. This is a part of the FGASA Bird Guide Certificate (regional).
- 3. You will need to book for the FGASA SKS Birding Theory exam and an Open Book Birding Slide Assessment. You must pass the exam and Open Book Assessment with 75% to be declared competent.

4. Once you have passed you will be awarded the FGASA SKS Birding Certificate.
