

# FGASA TRAILS GUIDE MENTOR PROCESS



**1. You need to be a Professional Trails Guide\* with at least 3 years workplace experience. You need to be an up-to-date member of FGASA.**

**2. You need to be nominated (in writing to FGASA Management) by at least 3 current Mentors.**

**3. The potential new Mentor must provide FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee with a comprehensive CV**

**4. You need to attend an interview with the FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee.**

**5. FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee must agree that the individual is suitable to be a mentor before they can be appointed.**

**6. The potential new Mentor must attend a training session**



**7.** You need to support FGASA and believe in what the Association is striving towards.

**IMPORTANT:**

**Becoming a Trails Guide Mentor** follows the process of being appointed to the position.

**It is not guaranteed** that you will automatically **qualify to become a mentor.**
