FGASA TRAILS GUIDE MENTOR PROCESS



You need to be a Professional Trails Guide* with at least 3
years workplace experience. You need to be an up-to-date member of FGASA.

2. You need to be nominated (in writing to FGASA Management) by at least 3 current Mentors.

3. The potential new Mentor must provide FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee with a comprehensive CV

4. You need to attend an interview with the FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee.

5. FGASA Management and SKS (DG) Standards Committee must agree that the individual is suitable to be a mentor before they can be appointed.

6. The potential new Mentor must attend a training session

7. You need to support FGASA and believe in what the Association is striving towards.

IMPORTANT:

Becoming a Trails Guide Mentor follows the process of being **appointed to the position.**

It is not guaranteed that you will automatically qualify to become a mentor.
